
### **EXECUTIVE SUMMARY OF KEY FINDINGS** (from 2023-24 end-of-year report)

The program achieved all five <u>Program Performance Objectives</u> (PPO). The objectives (<u>PPOs</u>) to be measured are established by the grant application submitted to the Ohio Department of Education. An evaluation plan was formed by the program leadership and the external evaluator at the beginning of the year to measure the programs' impact. Ohio's Performance Measures (PM) and Compliance Measures (CM) were also used to evaluate the effectiveness of the program (Appendix N).

### Evaluation Question 1: Have homework assistance opportunities benefited students?




**<u>Evaluation Question 2</u>**: What evidence is there to suggest the afterschool program is having an impact on students' reading outcomes?


PPO 1: By May 2024, 70% of students who attend afterschool for at least 30 days will increase

• **PPO 2:** By May 2024, 70% of students who attend afterschool for at least 30 days will increase their previous OST math score. (ACHIEVED)










